Intermediate (Level 2) – You work or want to work with children, You generally work under supervision. There is a diverse range of job roles for people with child care qualifications, examples;

- *Nursery nurse*
- *Childminder*
- *SureStart worker*
- *Special Educational Needs assistant*
- *Child care centre manager*
- *Preschool advisor.*

The Certificate and Diplomas in Children and Young People's Workforce and Diploma in Children's Care, Learning and Development cover a wide range of subjects, depending on your level and the options you choose. Topics include:

- *Understanding child and young person development*
- *Context and principles for early years provision*
- *Promoting the well-being and resilience of children and young people*
- *Supporting children and young people to achieve their education potential.*

These are work-based qualifications and you will be assessed whilst working with children, young people, their families and colleagues. You must be working in a real child care setting on a full time or part time basis and in paid or voluntary work.
